Minutes of a Meeting of Steventon Parish Council held on Tuesday 5th November 2019 in the Millennium Room of Steventon Village Hall

1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

2. PRESENT

Dr C Wilding Chair, Mr J Bennett, Mrs C Brickwood, Mr J Clark, Mrs C Denton, Mr R Green, Mr J Rice, Mr M Tucker and Mr M Stimpson-Tame. Mrs A Einon (Parish Clerk), Cllr Matthew Barber and Cllr Mike Fox-Davies were in attendance. There were fifteen members of the public present.

3. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY INTERESTS AND OTHER DECLARATIONS

To receive any declarations of disclosable pecuniary interests, and other declarations, in respect of items on the agenda for this meeting.

No declarations were received.

4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4.1. Little Green

It was explained that the Parish Council currently had a working group looking at the Little Green both parking and potholes. A proposal to install a strip on the edge of the green that was suitable for parking but that allowed the grass to grow, with post to stop further incursion. Residents would be asked for their input and suggestions for ongoing maintenance. Potholes would be looked at but some of the problem is caused by residents parking on their front verges and narrowing the road so that large vehicles, like the refuse truck, must drive on the grass.

4.2. Zebra crossing Hanney Road progress report

The costs of the zebra crossing had been agreed the plans are now out for consultation by OCC.

4.3. Bridge demolition update

Network Rail gave a presentation to the Parish Council and are to write to the village to inform of the current situation. The appeal by Network Rail for demolition is in abeyance until the end of April. The speed limit of 110mph has been agreed until 2021. A new timetable will be activated in December and there will be additional services running through from Swindon to Reading. Providing this works well the speed limit will be agreed for operation permanently and the bridge will be retained.

4.4. Verges and pavements

The Causeway verge south of the railway had still not been repaired, there had been proposals by Highways to install gabions to shore up the ditch side, but nothing had been done. Mike Fox-Davies agreed to raise this with Highways. Stonebridge road has been resurfaced but the pavements surfaces are dreadful. Mike Fox-Davies said that unfortunately pavements have very low priority and the problem was serious in all his area. Reports to Fixmystreet was the only option, he asked that copies of reports be sent to him. It was also reported that the speed indicator on Steventon bridge had many lights that were not working.

4.5. The Green tree maintenance

The recommended maintenance of trees on the Green had been completed. Two trees had been felled due to disease. A working party were looking into what species would be best to replace these with as the current problems with disease and infestation of trees reduced the options available.

5. REPORT FROM ANY COUNTY OR DISTRICT COUNCILLOR IN ATTENDANCE Clir Matthew Barber VWH

The Vale has adopted part 2 of the Local Plan. South Oxfordshire was causing concern as the Secretary of State had directed the council not to progress on the plan.

Festival grants were open for application. Additional garden waste would be collected on 11 November. The Council is continuing to look at decriminating parking, which requires that the Vale, South Oxfordshire and Cherwell need to sign up together. In the meantime, it was proposed to fund a PCSO.

Cllr Mike Fox-Davies OCC

Due to the General Election Oxfordshire County Council has paused the budgeting timetable. Integrated health and social planning are progressing towards coordination. The County to be carbon neutral by 2030 and zero carbon for transport by 2050. Streetlights are to be converted to led and solar panels installed on schools. Funds are available for Youth Services up to £70k. Chicane on the Hanney Road have asked to separate from the adoption of estate roads so that progress can be made on ditch ownership and installation of new priority access slightly further out of the village. OCC has objected to the Oxford to Cambridge expressway.

Met on 6th October in the burial ground. No new headstone problems had been found.

9.4 Recreation and Open Spaces – Trees, Greens, Waterways, Footpaths, Playground, Sports Hall. JC, CB, CD, RG, JR, MT, MST, CW

Mr Tucker had contacted several recreation equipment suppliers and had arranged meetings to discuss requirements.

The Clerk had yet to negotiate a price with Sarinc for the areas that the allotment warden was regularly cutting.

The work on the trees on the Green had been completed by Ringrose. Thinktrees had been asked to quote to examine and recommend actions for future maintenance requirements. The quote had been received: To cover all the trees from the survey carried out in 2017, reinspection and provide a report on the condition of the trees and their management requirements: £465. To use sonic tomography to map the decay and assess the extent of hollowness in four trees: £390. Measured aerial inspection of cavity in tree 17: £65. Total £920. The quote was discussed and agreed that an order should be placed for the work.

9.5 Village Infrastructure & Resilience – Railway, Roads, Drains JB, RG, JR, MT, CW. Resilience volunteers Rosemary Howden, Simon Holloway

Concerns were expressed on the length of time barriers were down on the level crossings. Mr Green would contact Network Rail and copy in Matthew Barber.

Emergency vehicles access to the village. Infrastructure to meet to decide on the letter to be sent to Network Rail, OSR, OCC, Fire Brigade, South Central ambulance and Police.

A sub-group was working on parking and verges on the Little Green. It was proposed to cost the installation of a firm surface 2 metres wide, which would allow the grass to grow through. The materials for the proposed 250 square metres would cost approximately £3k. The design and future maintenance would involve the residents agreeing to the proposals. Meeting to be arranged.

Pedestrian crossing

A site meeting was held on 14th October with Lee Turner, Mark Westwood, Mike Fox-Davies, Chris Wilding and the Clerk to discuss the additional humps required. The Parish Council had requested that rather than humps it be like the crossing in Drayton that had a table with extensive white lining. It was explained that this was not possible as there were no curbs on the Hanney Road to contain the sides of the table, it would also require drainage to be installed. The humps would be spaced so that lorries were able to cross them without bumping and causing problems for nearby residents. Consultation would be from early November with installation in February/March.

Steering group met on 14th October; further meeting arranged for 11th November. The length of time taken in preparing the Neighbourhood Plan which had resulted from changes of officers in the Vale, has resulted in some of the results used from 2015 to be considered outdated. The new developments particularly required to be evidenced. A new questionnaire was being drafted.

9.8 Website group CB, RG, JR, Clerk

The Clerk had been in touch with parish council users of two different website providers, both had been satisfied, but the feedback on usability and prompt contact was better for Parish Council Websites. The package we suggest is the Ultimate this will cost £499 to set up and £300 annually. It includes GDPR features, Cookie consent bar, SSL certificates and privacy policy page. It covers all Transparency code requirements has up to 40 pages, with unlimited pages via links. There is a choice of designs, easy update management system, and secure contact form. A decision was needed on a change of domain name to an .org extension or to remain with the present. The Parish Council agreed the expenditure and referred the domain name and design to the F&GP committee meeting.

John Clark reported that the Causeway Trust had done a survey of trees and were meeting on 6th November to discuss.

9.9.3 Thames Water Forum

Dr Wilding attended a meeting in London on Wednesday 16th October. The reservoir was still being pushed but there are other avenues, like the Severn water transfer, to be investigated. Decision unlikely until 2021 or early 2022. No independent assessment of proposals is a major concern as the water industry directorate is funded by the water industry.

12. PLANNING MATTERS

12.1. Applications
