Steventon Parish Council Meeting was held on Tuesday 6th September 2022 at 7pm in the Millennium Room of the Village Hall

1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies had been received from Mr M Stimpson-Tame and Cllr Sally Povolotsky(OCC & VWHDC).

2. PRESENT

Dr C Wilding, Chair, Mr Bennett, Mrs S, Broadbent, Mr J Clark, Mrs C Denton, and Mr J Rice. Mrs A Einon (Parish Clerk) was in attendance. The meeting was joined by four members of the public.

3. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY INTERESTS AND OTHER DECLARATIONS

To receive any declarations of disclosable pecuniary interests, and other declarations, in respect of items on the agenda for this meeting.

Dr Wilding declared an interest in the Planning application for 55 Hanney Road and left the meeting for this item.

4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4.1. Litter and graffiti

The litter bin near the village hall had disappeared. The Parish Council were aware and are proceeding on a replacement.

Play area – the table tennis area, the tables and the youth shelter have suffered from graffiti.

4.2. Truck

The pre-brief meeting had agreed to provide litter bins and sacks along the Causeway on the first day Friday there some bins near the Church but no bags. The sight organisers new nothing about litter bag provision some further bins were installed. Bags were installed and cleared by the Parish litter operatives along the Causeway. Cars had been parked in Castle Street and byway 16 and used to sleep in. Residents had observed their gardens used as a toilet.

The Copse had been extensively fouled with human waste. Were sufficient facilities available?

The parking permit system had not worked as copies had been circulating freely.

The fireworks at the end of the festival had been excessively loud and disturbing to residents and wildlife.

Residents who had wanted to contact the organizers were unable to find a telephone number though one had been given on the parking permits.

4.3. Litter and dog bins on estates

There are no bins on the Linden estate. This is the responsibility of the management company. Cllr Stimpson-Tame agreed to write to them concerning installations.

4.4. Roots and Shoots

Mrs Broadbent explained that the project was to provide community support so far an allotment had been allocated to grow food and teach others the procedures involved. The plan was to cook excess food and freeze it to be delivered or collected to families in need. Plans were also progressing on creating a warm space for drop in at the Church one day a week. East Hendred larder cooks on Tuesday and they had provided thirty frozen meals to Steventon. Rev Phil had distributed them to 8 families in Steventon.

4.5. Bus shelter Little Green

A request for a seat was made. The Parish Council agreed to look into this.

4.6. Speedwatch.

Cllr Sheenagh Broadbent read out a report from Steventon Community Speedwatch. Precise: We have 13 volunteer operators who are all fully trained at using the speed detection equipment. We have been operational since the beginning of July and we have been out 16 times. To date we have recorded over 70 offences that have been

reported to the Police and letters sent out. We have had a lot of support from villagers – people have stopped to talk and thank us, and we have had "friendly" waves and thumbs up from passers-by. The 3 signs that we think would be appropriate and are approved by Thames Valley Police. This would obviously need approving by the Parish Council and possibly anyone else with an interest – OCC/Highways? We would also need clips of an appropriate size so that they can be attached to the posts. The Parish Council had previously agreed to fund these.
