



Dear Friends

This month will certainly be a momentous one; possibly we will witness the only Coronation in our lifetime. King Charles III's coronation is steeped in this country's traditions and filled with great symbolism. This historical service will be set within a Eucharist (*thanksgiving*), the most central act of Christian worship. Prior to act of coronation, the King and then the Queen Consort are anointed with holy oil as a reminder to them and all who watch, that the authority and power vested in the monarch comes from God. The oil spooned onto their heads symbolises God's blessing being poured out on their heads as they are set apart to serve the people of our nation and Commonwealth with joy and humility. In essence the Coronation is a celebration of faith, service and community.

At the end of the month, on Sunday 28th May, we will again be celebrating an anointing and setting apart for faithful service and community building. This time the anointing is not on the head of a monarch or elected head of state, but on ordinary people; God bestows his blessing from the riches of his love and grace. The occasion is Pentecost or Whit Sunday, when the church celebrates God's blessing and anointing of his life giving Spirit not just on his first 12 disciples but on his disciples throughout time. Ordinary people resourced to show God's extraordinary love in all places and circumstances. Pentecost is regarded as the Church's birthday, the day when the Church started to live out the message of God's love throughout the world. We make a misjudgement if we consider the Church as historical buildings or institutions; the church is ordinary people, with diverse understandings of faithful living, seeking to show out the light of God's love in acts of compassionate, graceful giving. Pentecost is a call from God to live out our faith by receiving his strength which is made perfect in the weakness of our humanity. I pray that this coming month we will discern God's blessing to enable us to faithfully serve one another.



Parish Council Report

The Parish Council met on Tuesday 4th April with 7 Parish Councillors, Sally Povolotsky, Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) Councillor and Vale of White Horse District Council (VWHDC) and several members of the public being present.

Milton Park have given an update on the proposed cinder track cycle path. There were still some land ownership issues which may need to be dealt with through a Compulsory Purchase Order (CPO) process. The hope is that with the guaranteed funding being provided by Milton Park for this scheme, this will give OCC the ability to proceed with the CPO process if that is what it takes to deliver the Cinder Path cycle path. There is a concern that legal requirements might add an unnecessary burden to the process for delivering the path and it is hoped that OCC would keep pushing for speedy delivery of the project. Realistically we are probably looking at a year or two before a new Cinder Path cycle path opens.

Milton Park have also given feedback on Oxfordshire Bus Company's (OBC) objections to proposed 20mph speed limits being introduced. Their objection relates mainly to the blanket policy approach that with the principle of 20mph speed limits in areas where vulnerable road users mixed with heavy traffic. A blanket enforcement in all built up areas would have a detrimental effect on the bus timetable and would in some (but not all) cases, result in a reduced frequency of bus services. OBC's other point is that 20mph limits are rarely enforced and that buses are more likely than cars to observe the speed limit.

The next Parish Council meeting is on Tuesday May 9th, 2023, at 7pm in St. Michael's School Hall.




