Steventon Speedwatch Group



What is Community Speed Watch (CSW)? The Thames Valley Police (TVP) supported scheme has been active in Steventon since July 2022. The Scheme

aims to educate drivers in keeping to the speed limits to promote safety on the roads in the village.

Speedwatch is a proactive solution to improve the safety and quality of life for everyone in their community.

Are your sites approved by the Police?

Yes, each site we use has Police approval based on a range of factors, with each having been looked at individually.

Will I get fined or banned if Speedwatch take my details? No, the scheme is educational, not punitive - but the registered owner of the vehicle should

Will the Police knock on my door? It's a possibility if you persistently get recorded. If you do choose to consistently break the limit you do run the risk of a knock at the door from a uniformed officer.

What happens if I am seen gesturing, shouting, or swearing at Community Speedwatch volunteers?

All forms of abuse are recorded and reported to TVP, who will, if appropriate, write to the registered owner of the vehicle. In more extreme circumstances, or where this abuse is persistent, officers may, and have in the past visited drivers at home or at work. TVP will prosecute if a Public Order Offence is deemed to have taken place. Filming or photographing a Speedwatch group without permission is not allowed. There is a prosecution case currently going through the justice system of one such incident in the village from the summer.

What records are kept? CSW itself holds data in line with GDPR, as is all data sent to the Police, which is kept on their database, and used accordingly by TVP.

Is it ok to say hello when I see a team out and about? Of course – we may not always be able to give you our fullest attention, but we appreciate the many positive interactions we have had with Steventon residents.

So, is CSW making a difference to the speed of vehicles through the village?

Yes - along with the introduction of the 20mph zone, CSW has contributed to slowing the traffic. On the bridge alone over the past 8 months the percentage of drivers that pass during a session being recorded as speeding has more than halved from 25% to 11%. The average speed of driver's recorded has decreased from 38 to 29mph.






Steventon Mummers Mummers Plays have

been produced for centuries and are, or were, believed to bring

good luck to performers and audience. Meant as a recreation of the struggle between good and evil the plays were traditionally passed from generation to generation by word of mouth.

In December 1983 Steventon News gave the following account supplied by Tony Sloggett 'The characters being Molly, who was always played by a man, King George, a French officer called Beau Slasher, a doctor, Jack Vinny a jester, Happy Jack, a pauper and Old Beelzebub dressed up as Father Christmas... the Steventon mummers replace King George by an "Africky King".

The Steventon mummers performed, in their homemade costumes, after the traditional Christmas church service on Boxing Day and the players performed at village pubs etc. This custom seems to have ended by the beginning of the 20th century, and an appeal for 'writings' of the old play in the Parish Magazine in 1902 implies the original play had been forgotten. In recent years the mumming tradition has been revived with a team from the Abingdon Morris men visiting pubs in the village to perform the 'Sunningwell play' that was first written down in 1948.

Parish Council Report

The Parish Council met on Tuesday 7th November with 8 Parish Councillors, Sally Povolotsky, Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) Councillor and Vale of White Horse District Council (VWHDC) and several members of the public being present. The VWHDC have now determined their schedule for our Neighbourhood Plan. Formal consultation will commence at the end of November and last for a period of 7 weeks. Any comments will be addressed, and the plan then sent to the Government Inspector for consideration. It is hoped that a referendum will take place in April 2024. In December in the run up to Christmas, single bus fares in Oxfordshire will be capped at £1.

The Parish Council has written 2 letters to Therese Coffev and 1 to Steve Barclay former, and present Secretary of State for Environment stating our objections to the proposed 150 Mm3 capacity reservoir by Thames Water. The proposed new reservoir is based on limited "field studies" carried out in the 1990's and an original design produced in 2005. Modelling studies on the reservoir uses data from the 1990's with no new verified data being used since. There is an absence of any published documents on Safety and fault analysis of the reservoir. Environmental Impact Assessment, flood risk and Microclimate. We await their decision. Good progress is being made on the making of the first of a series of benches for installation around the village. The first incorporates a "timeline" on a spiral oak bench that will be installed on the big Green early in the New Year.

GARD is a local community group formed to campaign against Thames Water's proposals to build a reservoir south-west of Abingdon.

GARD has written to the Secretary of State for DEFRA (Therese Coffey) to ask her to confirm the timetable for her decision on the Thames Water plans, and particularly for the Mega-Reservoir. Our information on the grapevine is that this will be around the end of November. We will let all residents know her decision (Newsletter or Village website). Until then, GARD will continue to send in our list of Unresolved Issues about the Reservoir plan, which Thames Water refuse to answer properly. Looking at TW's "Statement of Response", GARD finds that they did not actually answer criticisms properly. If you feel that they have not answered complaints you made to Thames Water in the consultation, you can write to the Environment Agency and/or Ofwat and complain. This should be done as soon as possible, so it can inform the Secretary of State's decision.



In the meantime, Thames Water are on a 'charm offensive' trying to sell the Reservoir plans to local residents.

They were met by protesters at their 'Drop-in event' at East Hanney Village Hall on 10th November, when Councillor Sally Povolotsky and Helen Marshall (Oxfordshire Director for CPRE) were interviewed by Press and TV. Thanks to all protesters, including other Vale and Parish Councillors from Steventon. East Hanney and East Hendred. Thames Water gave the usual PR-based presentation (not a bulldozer in sight on any of the posters, one assumes the work will be done by birds and butterflies). We are promised 'leisure facilities' (which we already have, and which they have no idea how they will provide, after devastating the area), but our questions on disruption, pollution, flooding and safety of the structure were brushed aside.

We must keep up the pressure for the Reservoir plans to be scrapped!

Thank you very much to the 2,127 people who signed my petition to re-open Grove Station. It shows again the huge strength of feeling on this locally, and I will now be presenting it to the House of Commons and to the Department for Transport to make the case to them. Thanks too to Andy Holding of the Wantage and Grove Rail Supporters Group for his support. I will keep pushing for this station, which makes economic, social, and environmental sense. We are the proud home of the 11 EOD and Search Regiment at Vauxhall Barracks in Didcot, and it was a pleasure to visit again and meet Lt Col Rob Swan and the team. Just this year they have so far responded to more than 1,800 requests in the UK to deal with explosive devices and I planted a remembrance stake in Parliament's Garden of Remembrance in their honour. I also, as ever, took part in poignant remembrance services and parades – this year in Wantage and Didcot. Thank you to everyone who made them happen. UK Parliament Week takes place every November, and I was pleased to visit local schools and talk to different youth organisations about my role as an MP and how they can get involved in politics. including: Wallingford School, St Michael's CofE Primary School in Steventon, Brightwell Primary School, St Blaise Primary School, the 7th Abingdon Beavers, Chilton Explorer Scout Unit and Brightwell cum Sotwell Scouts. I have been campaigning to improve our roads since I was elected and I have now launched my Local Roads Survey to give you the opportunity to tell me exactly where you are seeing issues on our roads that need to be resolved – including potholes, congestion, speeding and other safety concerns.
